Located less than an hours drive from Oklahoma’s two largest cities, Lake McMurry offers swimming, fishing, boating, camping, mountain biking, hiking, bird watching, and hunting.

Lake McMurry is owned and operated by the City of Stillwater Parks Events and Recreation Department. It serves as a flood control reservoir, water supply and recreation area. At normal pool elevation (952) the lake covers approximately 1300 acres with 2100 acres of additional surrounding park land. Water depths range from 55 feet near the dam and less than 20 feet on the north end. The lake has 27 miles of shoreline. Lake McMurry has been stocked by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation with: bluegill, bass, catfish, walleye, and saugeye.

*** The Lake consists of two main sides.
East Recreation area: six miles west of State Highway 177 on Burriss Road
West Recreation area: Four miles west of Stillwater on Highway 51, turn north on Redlands Road and follow paved roads and park signs.

General Park Regulations:

1. All visitors must posses annual permit or purchase daily permit.
2. Vehicles must remain on designated roads at all times and park in designated parking areas.
3. All vehicles must be street legal and follow all traffic laws including 25 mph speed limit on park roads or on water unless posted otherwise.
4. Pets must be penned, caged or kept on a leash
5. Quiet hours in camping areas are 10 pm to 7 am
6. Following activities are prohibited: water skies, jet skies, wave runners, off road vehicles, fireworks, Intoxicating beverages including 3.2 beer, bow hunting/fishing, firearms, BB guns, air rifles, and other explosives

Swimming

- * Swim at your own risk.
- Please**
- * No containers of glass or tin allowed
- * No boats in swimming area
- * No pets in swimming area
- * No fishing in swimming area

Fishing:

- * Obey all State and Federal Regulations.
- * Only two poles/rods per person at one time
- * Fishing by net, seine, gun trap, bank lines, limb lines, jug lines, yo-yo’s or trotlines are prohibited
- * Fishing tournaments are to be scheduled with the Lake Manager two weeks prior to tournament date.

Boating:

- * Watercrafts must be properly registered by the State of Oklahoma.

Camping:

- * Primitive and improved campsites are available.
- * Please check City of Stillwater web or call lake office for reservations or more information.
- * Camping periods are limited to 14 consecutive days unless designated otherwise.
- * Camping is permitted in designated areas only.
- * Dumping waste/gray water on grounds is prohibited.
- * Fires in fire rings or grills only.
- * Sites shall not be occupied until you have a valid permit or authorization by Lake Manager or reservation.

Hiking/Mountain Biking

- * Presently there are two types of trails: trails for hikers only and trails shared with mountain bikes.
- * Pedestrians have the right of way, however hikers are to use courtesy and be aware of bike riders on shared trails.
- *Permits are required while biking.
- *Helmets are recommended while biking.

Hunting

- * By permit only.
- * Duck Blinds by drawing held in September each year.
- * See City Web or call Lake Office for more information

Schedule of Fees

Daily Fees

\$6	Daily use fee (Limit two mountain bikes)
\$9	Primitive and Water only Camping
\$18	Improved Camping water and elec.

All Camping

- * includes bank fishing, hiking, picnicking, and swimming
- * Daily use fee required for Boating and Mountain biking

- * Reservations may be made for any available camp sites beginning January 1.
- * Reservations require ½ of total amount paid at time of reservation, remainder paid at time of arrival.
- * Reservations from May-October require two nights minimum on weekends and three nights on major holidays.
- **Failure to pay deposit will forfeit reservations.
- **Failure to cancel reservations 10 days in advance of schedule will forfeit deposit.

Annual Fees

\$45	Resident Annual Permit
Persons living within the corporate city limits of Stillwater (per vehicle)	
\$70	Non-Resident Annual Permit
Persons not living within the corporate city limits of Stillwater (per vehicle)	
\$25	Additional Vehicle (limit one)

All Annual Fees include bank fishing, boating, hiking, mountain biking, picnicking and Swimming.
